

AFGHANISTAN | Geographic Distribution of the WHO-supported Healthcare Facilities for Trauma Care Services, as of April 2022

Trauma care is a priority for WHO and an area that WHO has been supporting since 2016. WHO supports 150 healthcare facilities across the country, including 13 Specialty Hospitals (SH), 6 Regional Hospitals (RH), 26 Provincial Hospitals (PH), 69 District Hospitals (DH), 31 Comprehensive Health Centers (CHC), 2 Teaching Hospitals, 2 Basic-Health Centers (BHC), and one Sub-Health center in terms of information management, building national capacity, strengthening service delivery, developing contingency and mass casualty management plans and conducting simulation exercises.
